The largest number of elk in the state of Montana is the Northern Yellowstone elk herd. Habitually, the elk migrate out of the park to winter range offering hunters the opportunity of a lifetime to harvest trophy bulls. We offer a very limited number of hunters this elite hunt. Accommodations include comfortable cabins and wonderful home cooked meals.

TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS GREATER YELLOWSTONE AREA HUNTING

Guests Driving: From Bozeman or Billings, take Interstate 90 to Livingston. At Livingston, head south on Highway 89 to Gardiner. At Gardiner, turn onto Jardine Road and continue for 2.5 miles. Turn right at sign that says North Yellowstone Outfitters.

Guests Flying: Plan to fly into the **Bozeman International Airport** (BZN) the day before your trip begins. The following airlines service Bozeman:
